Please print and fill out one for each person, fill in as you pack, and bring to camp with you. We will collect it on arrival day and return it on packing day. It will be helpful when packing to leave.

All items **MUST** be clearly and permanently marked with sewn on labels or Rub-a-Dub® laundry marker. Be sure to label clothes worn to camp. Campers and staff will wash clothes on site and hang them to dry. *This list is a guideline.* "Old" clothes are preferable, and the quicker they dry the better.

Note: Synthetic fabrics are more insulating than cotton when wet.

	Raincoat or poncho (Campmor's universal poncho is ideal: can double as shelter or ground cloth)			Flashlight and rechargeable batteries	
	Jacket or warm sweater			Sleeping bag (for overnights)	
	2 long-sleeved fleeces			1 or more stamped envelopes per week addressed to parent(s)	
	2 long-sleeved shirts			Extra stamps & envelopes	
	3 pairs quick-dry long pants			Non-aerosol insect repellent	
	3 pairs of shorts			Sunscreen	
	3 – 6 T-shirts			Vitamins, supplements, medicines	
	9 changes of underwear			shampoo, soap, tissues	
	5 – 8 pairs socks			comb and/or brush, hair ties	

Optional: Pocket knife, camera & film, hiking socks & liners, hiking boots, books, cotton items for tie-dying or silk-screening, backpack, water bottle, mess kit, fishing pole, musical instrument, stuffed animal

Leave at home: Money, food, candy, gum, radio, tape/ CD player, iPod, Kindle, laptop, cell phone, MAGIC cards, electronic games or toys, potentially offensive clothing, jewelry, MAD (and similar) magazines.
